Background to Project

- The Naboro Landfill was developed in 2005 through aid assistance from the EU and internal National Government funding.
- The site has a land area of approximately 31 hectares for use as disposal space potentially for the next 60 – 70 years depending on future waste inputs.
- The Landfill is made up of 5 broad planned stages of development over the course of the mentioned period.
 The Naboro Landfill at present is within Stage 1 of the 5 planned stages for the site.
