E sosolo lautele ona a'a fa'apei o ona lālā, ma fesoasoani e tāofi le oneone o matāfaga. O se la'au malosi e tali āfā, matagi malolosi, pisisami, lamala ma lologa.

This tree provides heavy shade. Leaves and nut oil are used in traditional Samoan medicine. Wood is used for making canoes, bowls, and houses. The roots of this tree spread at least as far as the canopy, helping to stabilize sandbanks. This tree withstands cyclones, wind, salt spray, drought, and occasional flooding.
