









State of the population

One of the biggest dugong population in the world, but with only hundreds of individual remaining. An isolated and vulnerable population

Habitat degradation

Poaching has not been officially quantified to date, but the testimonies and information collected are numerous and recurrent

Scientific knowledge from recent years shows that, given the number of remaining dugongs in New Caledonia, this population will decrease irrevocably as long as human threats will persist.




















Population census










Population size estimate

77 ind detected with certainty 408 ± 180



HOWEVER:

Several biais:

- Environmental factors
- Dual counting
- Observer biais

Compatibility with « standard protocol » is still an open question!!

→ Not possible to compare these results with previous census campaign
