


Protected Area Management

Pacific BioScapes Programme - Palau

The Pacific BioScapes Programme aims to increase site level management capacity for the protected areas of Palau. Palau currently has 38 Protected Area Network (PAN) sites and 14 other protected areas that encompass extensive marine and terrestrial reserves, areas of high biodiversity and vulnerable habitats. 608,173 km² of marine waters and 221 km² of land are protected. But an achievement like this means the resources to manage such large areas can often be stretched.

To increase capacity, The Nature Conservancy will provide support to the Protected Area Network Office under the Bureau of Environment of the Ministry of Agriculture, Fisheries and Environment and Palau Conservation Society and Division of Maritime Security and Fish and Wildlife Protection under the Bureau of Public Safety of the Ministry of Justice of Palau.
