UNDP supports disaster-prone countries in developing of comprehensive disaster risk reduction (DRR) programmes, strengthening of institutional and legislative systems, implementing community-level disaster preparedness activities, establishing coordination mechanisms to ensure the integration of risk reduction into human development, and in developing national capacities for recovery planning. UNDP's disaster risk reduction and recovery programming at national level focuses on three key areas: (i) strengthening national capacities in disaster prevention, risk reduction and reducing vulnerability to future hazard events; (ii) supporting the post-disaster response and recovery efforts; and (iii) addressing programming principles of UNDP (such as gender equality). At global level, UNDP provides services to high-risk countries such as policy guidance, advocacy, technical assistance, global knowledge sharing and partnership building with other global actors along the key thematic areas and programmes shown on the left navigation.

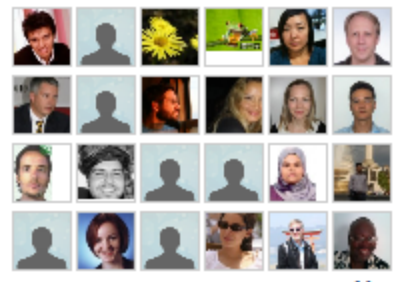
