

Be A True Citizen, Put Your Rubbish In The Right Place!



If you an urban dweller,

- 1) You should put your domestic rubbish (such as kitchen wastes, used papers, used plastic bags, empty tins) in plastic bags with the top tightly fastened or preferably in rubbish bins with their lids tightly sealed. Place them at the side of the road preferably on garbage stands secured from strayed animals, especially dogs. In this way they should be ready for collection by garbage collection trucks.
- 2) If you have access to a vehicle, you can transport and dispose off your own rubbish directly to the appropriate dump site which your town or area normally allocates for use.
- 3) Remember to **Reduce, Reuse and Recycle** any waste material as necessary.
- 4) Remember your kitchen wastes such as peelings and leftover food can also be fed to animals and to apply as compost on your home gardens and plants.

But, even if you live in an urban or rural area, **NEVER** throw your rubbish in any of these places....

- **The backyard of your house**
- **On the streets**
- **In a river, lake, stream or creek**
- **In a valley or cliff near your home**
- **In the sea**
- **On the beach**
- **Anywhere you want to.**
