Souvenirs and handicrafts can sometimes include plant and animal products that are protected under the Convention on International Trade in Endangered Species of Wild Fauna and Flora (CITES) or wildlife laws of Tonga.

PROHIBITED

TURTLE SHELL OR TURTLE PRODUCTS

WHALE AND DOLPHIN PARTS OR PRODUCTS

SHARK OR RAY PARTS OR PRODUCTS

RED SHINING PARROT AND POLYNESIAN MEGAPODE (MALAU) AND OTHER BIRDS



REGUIRES A PERMIT

GIANT CLAMS AND THEIR SHELLS OR MEAT ORCHIDS AND OTHER PLANTS



ASK FIRST

SEA CUCUMBERS
SOME CORALS AND SEASHELLS

YOU NEED A PERMIT TO EXPORT OR IMPORT SOME TYPES OF SEA CUCUMBERS, CORAL AND SHELLS – INCLUDING JEWELLERY MADE FROM THESE ITEMS.

ANY OTHER WILDLIFE: CONTACT DEPARTMENT OF ENVIRONMENT OR MINISTRY OF FISHERIES FOR INFORMATION.
