






















Interventions

Vanuatu

- Solar electrification in Vanuatu with implementation of a sector-specific Climate Early Warning System (710K)







Interventions

- Production of root crops more adapted to drought or rainfall
- Adapted livestock
- Coastal protection through mangrove rehabilitation
- Conture planting
- Agroforestry measures
- Fish Aggregating Devices











Solomon Islands (ACSE)

- Replacement of diesel-powered generation with low voltage solar grid smart system in large boarding schools (800 K)
- Development of accredited technical course programmes for solar technicians &airconditioning technicians at the Solomon Islands National University (SINU) and establishment of licensing system for industry practitioners (200K)
